



Efforts to Reduce and Recycle Plastic in Kitakyushu

Start Date	Activity
Nov 1997	Start of separation and collection of PET bottles
Jul 2000	Start of base collection of trays (supermarkets, civic centers, etc.) *White trays (started in 2000), color trays (started in 2002)
Jul 2006	Review of household waste collection system (Revision of charges, introduction of paid bags for recycling, start of separation of plastic containers and packaging)
2009	Bus tours on recycling of plastic containers and packaging
Jun 2018	<u>Discontinuation of distribution of free plastic shopping bags</u> on the basis of agreements with businesses (about 80 supermarkets in the city)

O Objective

Learn about recycling-oriented and low-carbon societies through tours on sorting and recycling plastic containers and packaging for the effective utilization of resources and to solve global warming issues

- O Target: 5th and 6th graders in public elementary schools
- O Tour contents: Separation work at plastic recycling centers, etc.
- O Number of participants: About 2,000 in total (Since 2009)






Fraser's Hill is a typical tourist spot in Malaysia. However, immediate measures are needed to respond to pressure on the remaining capacity of the final disposal site and groundwater contamination.

The Solid Waste Management and Public Cleansing Corporation (PPSPPA) of Malaysia supports the improvement of waste management and capacity by providing guidance to the Fraser's Hill Local Authority (FHLA).

[Activities]

- Separation and collection of recyclables and development of a recycling system
- Separation and collection of organic waste from businesses and development of a composting system
- Surveys on the current state of environmental pollution at the former disposal site, development of pollution prevention guidelines, and recommendations for measures to extend the life of the current disposal site.


